As a novelist, theologian, and “one of America’s most important voices on religion and culture” (BBC Radio), Greg Garrett has made story the focus of his work. In the process of telling his own stories and teaching those of others, he’s discovered archetypal patterns people have used for thousands of years to make sense of their lives and of the world; sometimes stories break apart in the presence of loss and we have to find new ones.



Garrett will focus on his writing, both fiction and memoir, the books on U2, Harry Potter, the afterlife, and the theological. Garrett will make connections to the new edition of *Crossing Myself*, his memoir, recently republished in October from Church Publishing and his forthcoming book from Oxford on the Zombie Apocalypse, *Living with the Living Dead*.
