Scope of Responsibility: Responsible for the supervision and care of children whose parents are attending St. Mark's Episcopal Church's Sunday morning programming, and any other church sponsored events where childcare is needed.

Main Job Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Supervision of children
- Planning and carrying out age appropriate activities
- Providing beverages and snacks when needed
- Changing diapers
- Helping children with toileting needs
- Working with children needing additional behavior assistance
- Various other duties as assigned

Characteristics of a Successful Childcare Provider:

- Treats children in a kind and nurturing manner.
- Interacts and plays with children during their time in the nursery.
- Arrives on time or early for scheduled shift.
- Performs all duties thoroughly and in a timely manner.
- Maintains a willing and flexible attitude to attend to the duties assigned.

Part-Time: Approximately 5-10 hrs/wk
