# **Open Position: Dishwasher**

Reports to Special Events Coordinator

Provide clean, spotless and sanitary dishes, service ware, and glass ware so all employees can better serve our guests. Maintain clean, dry and organized kitchen, dishwashing area, and meeting areas. Position will require cleaning, particularly in kitchen and related areas.

Part-time - 19 hours per week, afternoon and evening shift. Some weekend mornings required. Position pays \$10.00 per hour.

#### **Essential job functions:**

- Carefully operate the dish machine according to standards to ensure highest quality results (clean serviceware) with minimal breakage knowing that our guests' experience will be enhanced by the results.
- Keep the dish machine clean and report any functional or mechanical problems immediately.
- Monitor dish machine water temperature to ensure sanitary wash cycle
- Wash and store all tableware and kitchenware.
- Keep dish room, kitchen, and meeting rooms clean and organized.
- Maintain adequate levels of clean tableware for dining room and kitchen.
- Bag and haul dish room trash to dumpster at designed times.
- Clean food preparation, production areas, and meeting rooms.
- Must arrive to work on time, well-groomed, and in clean and pressed attire according to St. Mark's dress and appearance standards.

# Requirements:

- Previous restaurant experience helpful
- Be able to work in hot, wet, and loud environment for long periods of time
- Be able to lift, reach, bend, and stoop
- Be able to working in a standing position for long periods of time (up to 8 hours)
- Be able to safely lift bags, cases weighing up to 40 pounds up to 20 times per shift
- Be able to safely lift stacks of plates weighing up to 30 pounds
- Be able to use a mop, broom, or squeegee
- Must be able to understand / follow procedures for specific food preparation duties when required
