Free parking is available in the lot at the corner of Jefferson and East Pecan, next to the church.

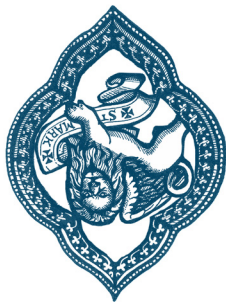
