We engage in feeding those hungry for knowledge and meaning through formation classes for all ages and worship offerings. We engage in feeding those hungry for beauty and creativity through our choirs, music offerings to the city, and art exhibits.

Open Position: Sexton/Housekeeper

Reports to Facilities Manager

<u>Scope of Responsibility</u>: Perform assigned duties from Facilities Manager as related to cleaning, event set-up, and other duties deemed pertinent by the Facilities Manager. This position will be responsible for maintaining a regular cleaning schedule for the facilities and work with other sextons to complete all housekeeping tasks in a timely, regular manner.

Main Job Tasks and Responsibilities

- Sweep, mop, and polish floors as needed
- Vacuum and clean carpets and upholstery
- Dust and polish furniture and fittings
- Empty and clean trash containers
- Clean restrooms regularly, inspect and address restocking needs daily
- Wipe down glass surfaces
- Tidy up rooms
- Maintain all cleaning equipment and materials in a safe and sanitary working condition
- Monitor and report necessary domestic repairs and replacements to Facility Manager
- Review event book daily to determine what housekeeping tasks are scheduled for the day.
- Make sure that cleaning carts are ready with supplies.
- Be sure that rooms are locked after being cleaned.
- Follow up on all tasks to be performed after an event is completed (removing dirty table linens, vacuuming, emptying trash receptacles, etc.)
- Report any building maintenance issues that needs attention to Facilities Manager.

Mostly Monday – Friday, though some weekends required.
